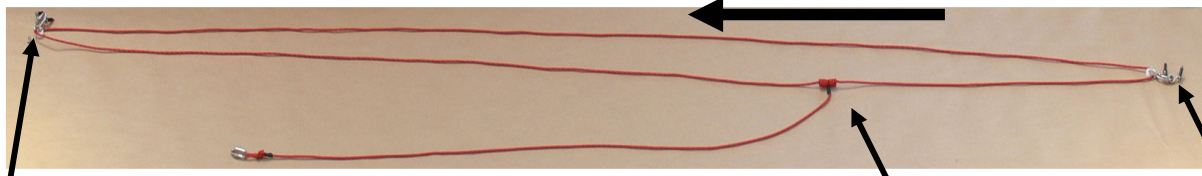
Grapnel Anchor



Running Rig

Running Rig: How it works

Pull rope in this direction to move Grapnel Anchor to the stern



Fastenings to Attach to **Bow** of kayak



Use the Shackle to attach the Anchor



Fastenings to Attach to **Stern** of kayak

1 Attach **Grapnel Anchor** to the **Running Rig**



2 Release the **Grapnel Anchor** and chain



Release the **Grapnel Anchor** and chain to the bottom and play out enough rope to ensure the anchor will hold.

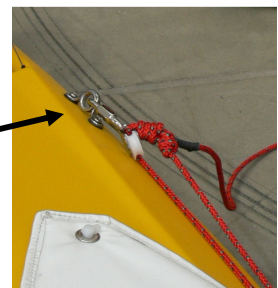
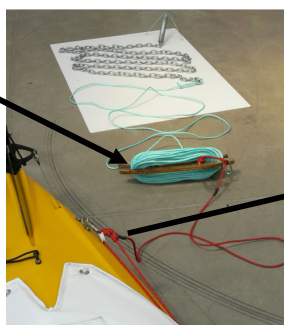


Tie off the anchor rope at this length using a simple half-hitch around the body of the anchor winder-board. A second half-hitch may be added if required.



3 Release the Anchor Winder. Deploy **Grapnel Anchor** to the stern of the kayak using the **Running Rig**

Release the Anchor Winder-Board over the side (AFTER ensuring step 1 has been completed) and deploy the **Grapnel Anchor** to the stern of the kayak using the **Running Rig**.



Grapnel Anchor deployed to stern

Typically when fishing under anchor the **Grapple Anchor** is run to the stern of the kayak to allow bait to drift away forward. This gives the correct line angle for hooking and playing fish.

Remember, the larger fish will try and tow the kayak, having the **Grapple Anchor** at the stern will minimize the risk of tangles.

4 Recover the **Grapple Anchor**



Use the **Running Rig** to bring the **Grapple Anchor** to the side of the cockpit for recovery onboard
