Individual and team event, with a new Adventure Race team option. It will provide a challenge for all and a chance to take advantage of the fantastic environment we have on our doorstep.

The Maungatautari Ecological Island Trust was set up to build and maintain a totally pest proof fence around the forest on Maungatautari, in order to eliminate all warm-blooded animal pests from the mountain. If you are keen to help us support the Maungatautari Island Trust Scheme then this is the event for you! **\$10 from every entry will go to supporting this great cause.** Last year over \$2500 was donated!

Course Description:

Leg 1: Leamington to Pukeatua - 32 km Road Cycle. Race start at Roto-o-rangi Road. Left onto Parklands Rd to T Junction. Right onto Monckton Rd. Left onto Arapuni and into Pukeatua. Transition 1 at Out in the Styx Café (*support crew please take note of transition notes overleaf*).

Leg 2: Tari Rd to Maungatautari School - 15km Run over Maungatautari Mountain, via the old track. Run down to the end of Hicks Rd and the second transition at Maungatautari School Car park.

Leg 3: Maungatautari School to Horahora domain - 15km Road Cycle. From the Maungatautari School Car park go left down Maungatautari Road, left onto Maungatautari Hill Rd, past Horahora School, left onto Plantation Rd and onto Horahora Domain.

Leg 4: Horahora domain to the Boatshed - 10km Kayak or row from Horahora Domain under the Horahora Bridge and down the lake to the Boatshed Café & Kayaks Landing.

Kayak Hire - If you need to hire a kayak, a large range of both multisport and sea-kayaks are available from The Boatshed. Contact us ASAP. Adventure race kayaks are also available.

Safety:

■ We recommend that bikes and kayaks are checked prior to race day. Bikes can be checked at Cycle Time Hamilton, and kayaks at The Boatshed Cafe & Kayaks, Cambridge.

■ Polypropylene clothing (tops and bottoms), hat, gloves, waterproof jacket and basic first aid kit including compass, is compulsory on the run leg. (First aid kit includes: survival blanket, crepe bandage, strapping tape, scissors, 10 x band-aids)

■ Certified cycle helmets must be worn on the road at all times.

■ Normal road rules apply and must be adhered to.

■ Approved buoyancy aid must be worn on the water and positive buoyancy devices installed in all kayaks.

■ Bibs to be worn on top of all clothing.

■ Please note there is no water supply at kayak start

■ If a competitor pulls out, they must inform the nearest marshal as soon as possible.



Timetable:

Friday 4th June - Registration from 2pm – 8pm at the Boatshed Café and Kayaks, 21 Amber Lane, Cambridge

Saturday 5th of June 2009

■ 7am - 7.45am Registration at **Leamington Primary School, Lamb St, Cambridge**

■ 7.45am Race briefing outside **Leamington Primary School, Lamb St**. The start line will be on the corner of **Lamb St & Roto-o-rangi Rd**. All participants must attend this race/safety briefing.

■ 8.10am ALL Support Cars leave for Transition 1

■ 8.30am Race Start

■ 4pm Prize giving. Some competitors will be finishing after the prize giving has commenced.

Notes to Support Crews:

Start Line – Immediately after Race Briefing all support cars **must** leave for Transition 1 at Out in the Styx Café, Pukeatua. This is to reduce congestion on the road. There will be a support van following the last cyclist.

Transition 1 (Cycle to Run) – Out in the Styx Café, Pukeatua. Follow above directions for Leg 1. Whilst waiting for your cyclists to come in, enjoy a cup of coffee or a bite to eat at this great café.

Transition 2 (Run to Cycle) – Maungatautari School Carpark. From Pukeatua, head towards Arapuni. Turn left onto Orepunga Rd. Follow signs to Maungatautari via Horahora. At T-Intersection of Hicks Rd and Maungatautari Road. (Refer to map issued at registration). **Because of a lack of parking available this will be an unassisted transition.** Once your competitor is into the run, support crew will drop appropriate gear (cycle etc) here to the safety of marshals, and in order of race number, then carry on to Horahora Domain. Please drop off gear and move onto next transition ASAP. Mountain running gear will be picked up by the marshals and taken to prize-giving so make sure it's named! Please do not return to pick up your competitor's gear.

Transition 3 (Cycle to Kayak) – Horahora Domain. Follow above directions under Leg 3. Cyclists will have to dismount their bikes on the left-hand side of the road then walk their cycles across the road into the domain to their waiting support crews and kayaks.

From here all support vehicles will travel across the Horahora bridge, and turn left onto SH1 towards Cambridge. The Finish Line is at The Boatshed Café & Kayaks, turn left onto Gorton Rd and follow signs to the Café on Amber Lane.
